# Abortion & history

- ▣ - Hippocratic Oath dating back to the 4<sup>th</sup> Century B.C. , forbade abortion & euthanasia
- ▣ - Christian morality has maintained the moral evil of abortion since the 1<sup>st</sup> Century A.D.
- ▣ - Common Law dating back to the Middle Ages treated abortion as a grave crime.
- ▣ - 1802, England enacts law against abortion that had been considered a criminal offence by custom for centuries.

# Canadian abortion explosion after legalization

- ▣ - 1969 abortions = **268** (the year abortion law changed).
- ▣ - 1970 abortions = **11,000**.
- ▣ - 1971 abortions = **30,929**.
- ▣ - 1972 abortions = **38,905**. The number of abortions kept rising with each year.
- ▣ - **1982 , abortions outnumbered live-births in the city of Toronto.**
- ▣ Eventually the number of annual abortion rate levels out at about **100,000 annually**.

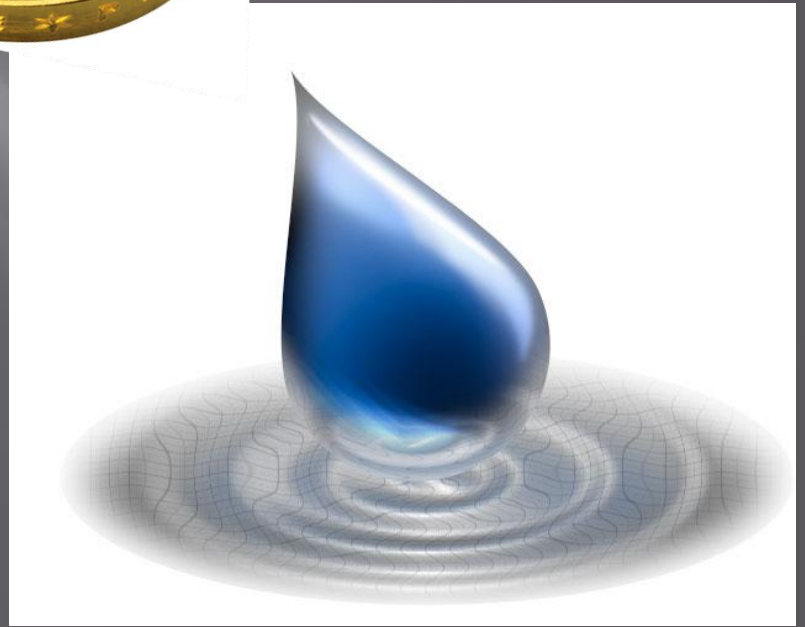
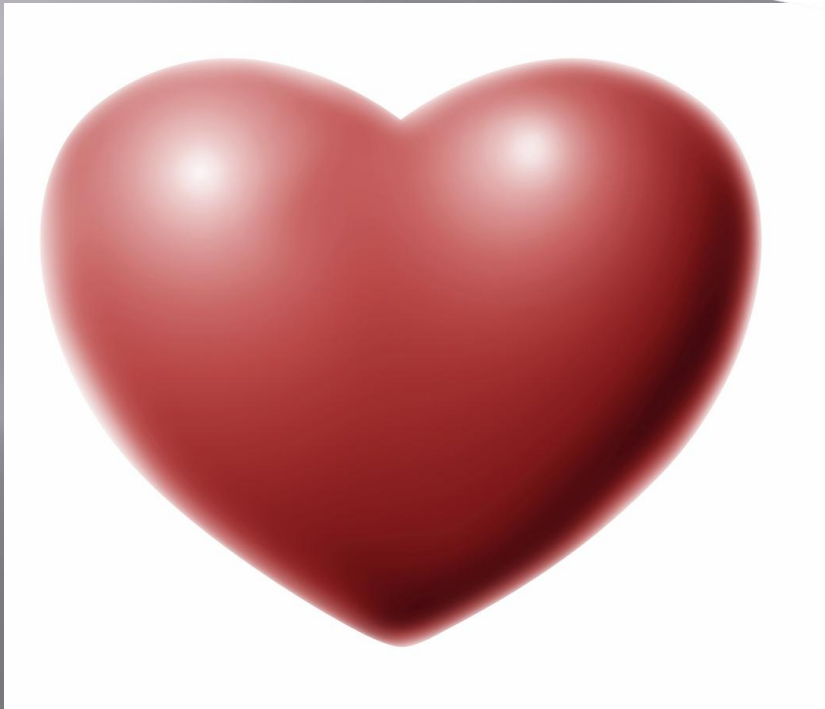




































What is the true extent
